LEVELS

For a good development of the workshops, and in respect to teachers and participants, please follow the most appropriate level for you

OPEN LEVEL: This level includes everyone. Workshops are prepared for dancers that know basic steps, basic and combined turns and some additional steps and variations. If you are from **Sport im Park**, this is your perfect spot! Some workshops are focused on rhytms and variations and don't need previous knowledge.

INTERMEDIATE: This level includes more experienced dancers. Workshops are prepared for participants that dance safely and with confidence to the rhythm, have control of space and direction, and know more complex movements.

ADVANCED: This level includes very experienced dancers. Workshops are prepared for participants that have control of rhythms/dance/music and dialog with partner. Dancers know many complex figures and combinations of them (as Giro Paulista, Cadena, Trocadilho, Push and Pull, ...) and dance with confidence and smooth improvisation.

In 2017 she started teaching Forró in Magdeburg, Germany, combining her academic knowledge in sports science with her passion for dance. Since 2022, she has been teaching regular classes and workshops globally in both Roots and Universitário styles. Her focus is on teaching comfortable leading for both partners, strengthening the connection and encouraring an active follower role. Kim was a regular teacher in Forró Hannover and she is the main organizer of <u>Tonelada de Forró</u> Festival.

Accordionist from Rio Grande do Norte, Brazil, and currently based in Portugal, Carol concert presents Forró through traditional repertoire and original songs that are part of her first album - Lampejo. Carol worked with major artists like Quinteto Violado, Chico César, Trio Nordestino, and Lucy Alves, and was part of the female trio Maria Sem Vergonha and Balaio Nordeste Accordion Orchestra, performing at festivals in Brazil, Portugal, Spain, Germany, and Ireland. Carol is a PhD student in Ethnomusicology at the Univ. of Aveiro and teaches accordion at the Federal Institute of Rio Grande do Norte.
